If you require any further information about your child's learning, please speak to any member of the Year 2 team.

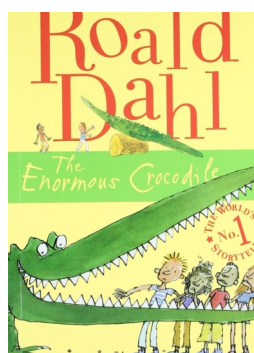

Literacy

Our Literacy learning will be based around the text 'The Enormous Crocodile'. The story focuses on an enormous crocodile leaving the muddy river to search for little children to eat. Once they are familiar with the story, the children will write a recount of the key events of each chapter. When reading, the children will develop their inference skills and focus on the effect of vocabulary choices.



Mathematics

During the Summer term, the children will:

- ◆ Continue to read and write numbers to 100.
- ◆ Continue to develop their understanding of place value in numbers up to 100.
- ◆ Use reasoning to solve problems using addition and subtraction.
- ◆ Continue to count forwards and backwards in twos, fives and tens.
- ◆ Compare and order length, mass and capacity.
- ◆ Compare and sequence intervals of time.
- ◆ Use the correct mathematical vocabulary to explain their reasoning.



Science

Our Science learning will continue to focus on plants. The children will:

- ◆ Label the main parts of a plant and explain their function.
- ◆ Observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants.
- ◆ Record how the height of a plant changes over time.
- ◆ Find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.
- ◆ Sequence the different stages in a plant's life.



Foundation Subjects

During our topic, 'Knights and Castles', the children will:

- ◆ Find out about different types of castles that were built in the UK.
- ◆ Be transported back in time to 1275 and experience what it would be like to work in a medieval castle
- ◆ Learn about the main methods of defending and attacking a castle.
- ◆ Design and create a drawbridge for a castle.



Personal, Social, Religious and Emotional Development



In Religious Education, the children will be exploring the question 'What is the 'good news' Christians believe Jesus brings? '

In PSHE, the children will learn about health and wellbeing, including why sleep is important and keeping healthy. The children will explore how they manage their feelings and when to ask for help.

PE

During PE lessons, the children will be learning to strike and field in a game of cricket. They will work as part of a team, learning to value the contributions of all members. They will learn to intercept and stop the ball with consistency and sometimes catch the ball.
