

# English

Mathematics

Our learning will be based around the text 'Rapunzel' by Sarah Gibb. The children will recount the story from the point of view **RAPUNZEL** of Rapunzel with a focus on using interesting vocabulary. They will include their own garden description in their writing. When reading, the children will develop their retrieval skills by highlighting key information in the text and using it to answer questions.



During the Summer Term, the children will:


- Continue to read and write numbers to 100.
- Continue to develop their understanding of place value in numbers up to 100.



- Use reasoning to solve problems using addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
- Compare and order length, mass and capacity.
- Compare and sequence intervals of time.
- Use the correct mathematical vocabulary to explain their reasoning.

Our science learning will continue to focus on plants. The children will:

- Label the main parts of a plant and explain their function.
- Observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants.



- Find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.
- Sequence the different stages in a plant's life.



Science


During our topic, 'Knights and Castles', the children will:

- Find out about different types of castles that were built in the UK.
- Be transported back in time to 1275 and experience what it would be like to work in a medieval castle
- Learn about the main methods of defending and attacking a castle.
- Design and create a drawbridge for a castle.
