YEAR 6 VISIT SWYNNERTON PARK

A HUGE well done to our Year 6 class who visited Swynnerton Park. Their day was entitled, 'Countryside Learning working with Estate Owners and Farmers to Educate, Inform and Inspire'. The visit provided an opportunity to learn how important the

countryside is to all of us and how we need to look after it. The children took part in a wide range of activities which included meeting with Lord Stafford and exploring the kitchen garden. The children planted strawberry plants and were able to bring one home. They met a working sheep farmer, his sheep and two-weekold lambs. They watched one of the adult sheep having their yearly shear. Then they learned how the fleece is processed by hand, spun and turned into wool to create various products including clothing, rope and nets. They met a local dairy farmer and made their own butter from full-fat cream. They also met with the estate gamekeepers and learned how the estate controls pests across the land. Finally, they spent time with a local beekeeper, some of their swarm and were able to bring away some of the local honey to sample. To end a wonderful day, the children met the

'hunt' horses and friendly foxhounds.
The children enjoyed an extremely busy and informative day. As always, they were a credit to the school and made us extremely proud. Very well done Year 6, what a fabulous day out in the countryside.

INCREASE IN SCHOOL DINNER CHARGES

We have been informed by City Catering that due to food inflation, there will be an increase in the price of school dinners from September 2023.

The price of a Nursery school dinner will increase from £2.12 to **£2.50**. The price of a dinner for children in Year 3, Year 4 , Year 5 and Year 6 will increase from £2.60 to £3.30.
