# Price Increase

#### INCREASE IN SCHOOL DINNER CHARGES

We have been informed by City Catering that due to food inflation, there will be an increase in the price of school dinners from September 2023.

The price of a Nursery school dinner will increase from £2.12 to £2.50. The price of a dinner for children in Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 will increase from £2.60 to £3.30. Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are still entitled to Universal Infant Free School Meals.
