
<u>YEAR 6 VISIT PARK HALL AND POTTERIES MUSEUM</u> <u>AND ART GALLERY</u> A HUGE well done to our Year 6 class who visited Park Hall Country Park and

Hanley Museum last week. They started the day with a mini-beast hunt in the quarry and carried out pond dipping, classifying the creatures that they found. They learnt about the history of the site from when it was a quarry and how, over time, humans have allowed nature to take over the site.

At the museum, the children learnt about food chains, which involved mapping out food chains and food webs. They saw the food chains as they were made up using the stuffed animals from the museum's displays and were able to get up close to look at and touch the animals (including a fox, rabbit, hawk and blackbird). They used magnifying glasses to study the different parts of beetles and looked for



similarities between different species of beetles. Finally they discussed the impact that humans have had over time on the landscape and nature of the local area (both positively and negatively). The children enjoyed an extremely busy and informative day, despite the heavy rain. As always, they were a credit to the school and made us extremely proud. Very well done Year 6, what a fabulous day out in both the countryside and when studying at the museum.
