


KEY STAGE 2 CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION

YEAR 1 VISIT HANLEY MUSEUM AND ART GALLERY Year 1 visited Hanley Museum and Art Gallery last week to

develop and enrich their history learning. They took part in an exciting workshop to discover more about toys from the past. They explored the types of toys including dolls and teddy bears from over a hundred years ago. They then played with a range of toys including spinning tops and a Jack-in-a box. They were fascinated to discover what they were made from and how they moved. They were then able to make their own toy based on the cup and ball game. They finished the day with a tour of the rest of the museum and looked at the natural history and local history

galleries. They explored a wide range of animals, the

Victorian street and the Spitfire exhibit. Well done to our wonderful Year 1 historians you are fabulous ambassadors for our school and you have made us very proud.







THE RAINFOREST ROADSHOW VISITS YEAR 4

Very well done to our Year 4 biologists, explorers and anthropologists who recently enjoyed a very special visit from Dave from the Rainforest Roadshow to enrich their learning about rainforests. The children were fascinated as the tropical rainforest was brought to life in front of their eyes. They marvelled at the leaf insects, the tarantula called Amelia and the giant millipede. They examined tribal artefacts and found out a wide range of interesting facts about the way of life of the people who make the rainforest their home.

The children learnt to make traditional tribal necklaces and had their faces or arms painted in the tribal patterns of the indigenous tribes of the Amazon. Finally, they tried on necklaces and parrot headdresses (made by the tribes) as Dave used hand whittled instruments to imitate the sounds of the birds who reside there. They found the day utterly fascinating, showed a superb attitude to their learning and were inspired by the real life tales of Dave's travels through the rainforest. At the end of the day, he congratulated the children on their

behaviour, respectfulness and enthusiasm. Well done to our Year 4 ~ we are very proud of your interest and passion for learning!
