KEEPING SAFE ON THE ROADS

This week, our children in Year 3 and Year 4 took part in Road Safety Awareness training delivered by the Staffordshire Safer Roads Partnership. The children began by completing activities in the classroom and then they set off to consolidate their learning on a training walk around the local area with their teachers and the Road Safety Education Officer. Now that they have practised their skills, next week they will demonstrate what they have learned by walking independently with adult supervision.

Certificates and pencils will then be awarded to each child in recognition of their sensible and responsible approach to keeping safe.

In Year 1 and Year 2, the children explored seatbelt safety.

They found out how to be a safe passenger in a car by taking part in an interactive presentation. They then carried out experiments using Humpty Dumpty (a hard boiled egg) to find out about the dangers of not wearing a seat belt.

All the children worked with great interest and we are very proud of them all for understanding the importance of learning to keep safe when travelling or walking on the roads.
