Literacy

Mathematics

Our learning will be based around the text 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea' by Judith Kerr, a story about an unexpected visitor during tea time. The children will write their own version of the story and plan out their own alternative ending. During reading lessons, the children will develop their inference skills by finding answers in the text as well as learning to read with expression.



During the term, the children will:

- Read, write and interpret mathematical statements.
- Recognise and name common 2D and 3D shapes.
- Read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in numerals and words.



- Recognise and know the value of different denominations of coins and notes.
- Solve one-step problems that involve addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
- Describe position, direction and movement, including whole, half, quarter and three-quarter turns.

Our Science learning will focus on 'Animal Including Humans' and 'Plants'. The children will learn:

- That animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults.
- How to group and compare different animals.
- What a plant needs in order to grow.
- How to identify and describe the basic structure of some common flowering plants and trees.

To complete our topic 'Let's Play', the children will learn about:

- What life was like in the past and the toys that children played with and make comparisons to life and toys today.
- How to design and make their own puppet.

During our topic 'It's A Bugs life', the children will learn about:

- The life cycle of butterflies.
- Parts of an insect's body.
- How to classify insects that we find on a bug hunt.
- How Bees help our environment.

In Religious Education, the children will be exploring the question: 'What makes some places sacred?'

In PSHE, the children will learn about British Values and living in the wider world. The children will learn about the roles of the emergency services and how the help us. They will also learn to identify their own network of support.

ш 1 During PE lessons, the children will learn to master basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching. The children will develop their control over their bodies and the equipment used when beginning to take part in team games.
