Our learning in geography, science and art will be centered around the topic 'Animal Kingdom' - a topic which the children are eager to learn about.



Mathematics

Mr Fox' by Roald Dahl which focuses on a fox who resorts to his natural craftiness to rise above the opposition faced by local farmers. After they have familiarised themselves with the story, the children will write a recount of the key events of each chapter. When reading, the children will develop their inference skills and focus on the effect of vocabulary choices.



During the term, the children will:

- Measure, compare, add and subtract lengths, mass and capacity.
- Record and compare time in terms of seconds, minutes and hours.
- Count up and down in tenths.
- Add and subtract fractions with the same denominator.
- Write and calculate mathematical statements for multiplication and division including two-digit numbers times one-digit numbers, using mental and progressing to formal written methods.



As part of our learning about animals including humans, the children will:

- Identify that animals and humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition and that they cannot make their own food.
- Identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.



During the topic 'Animal Kingdom,' the children will learn about: Locating countries on a map.

The temperature zones of the earth, including the equator.



How animals live, find food and keep themselves safe.

In Religious Education, the children will be exploring the questions: 'Why do people pray?' and 'Why is the Bible so important for Christians today?'
