If you require any further information about your child's learning, please speak to any member of the Year 1 team.

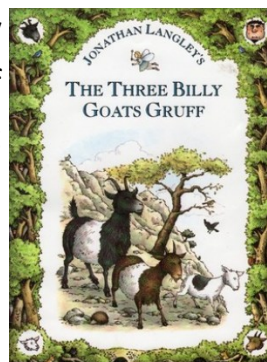

Literacy

Our learning will be based around the text 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff' by Jonathan Langley which focuses on a group of hungry Billy Goats as they try to get past the ugly Troll that guards the bridge. The children will recount the story as well as writing instructions for how to cross a bridge. When reading, the children will develop comprehension skills and focus on locating information in a text to answer questions.



Mathematics

During the term, the children will:

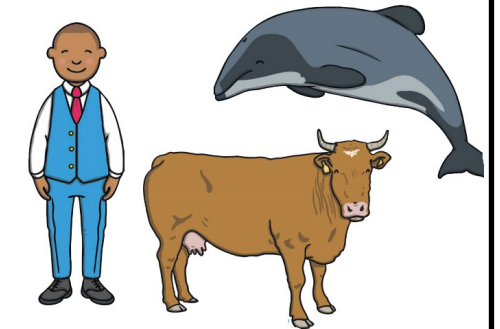
- ♦ Add and subtract within 20.
- ♦ Count, read and write numbers to 50 in numerals and count in multiples of twos and tens.
- ♦ Read and write mathematical statements involving the addition, subtraction and equal signs.
- ♦ Measure and record lengths, heights, capacity and volume.
- ♦ Read and write numbers from 1-20 in numerals and words.



Science

This term, in Science lessons, the children will learn about animals including humans. The children will:

- Identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.
- Identify and name a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.



Foundation Subjects

During our topic, 'Take a Walk on the Wild Side', the children will:

- ♦ Locate and name the continents.
- ♦ Make traditional aboriginal art.
- ♦ Learn about African animals and their habitats.
- ♦ Explore the weather of African countries.



Personal, Social, Religious and Emotional Development



In Religious Education, the children will be exploring the question 'Who is Jewish and how do they live?'

In PSHE, the children will learn about living in the wider world. They will look at what rules are and how to care for others' needs; as well as how to look after the environment. The children will learn to use the Internet and digital devices safely.
